LO: Addition and Subtraction of Decimals

- 1) Peter cuts a piece of string into 2 lengths. One is 4.23 cm long, one is 3.59 cm long. How long was the string before it was cut?
- 2) Mary joins 2 lengths of wood together. One is 17.402 cm long, the other one is 2.229 cm long. How long is that altogether?
- 3) Mrs. Warburton weighs her suitcases ready for her holidays. It weighs 7.38kg. She takes out shoes that weigh 2.6kg. How heavy is her suitcase now?
- 4) I have 2 bags of sweets. One weighs 64.182g; one weighs 8.98g. How much do they weigh altogether?
- 5) Kelly collected 45.6ml of rain on Sunday. 6.72ml of water evaporated overnight. How much rain was left in the beaker on Monday?
- 6) Sarah has 2 friends. Lauren is 1.48m tall and Sophie is 1.521m tall. If they both stood on top of each other how high would they be?
- 7) Mrs. Warburton weighed 63.9kg after Christmas. She went on a diet and lost 4.287kg. How much does she weigh now?
- 8) Allan runs 7.632km on Monday and 6.599km on Tuesday. Find the total of his runs.
- 9) In a gymnastics competition Lizzie scored 12.6 points on vault. Jaspreet scored 2.59 points fewer than Lizzie. What is Jaspreet's score?
