2) $18 \%$ of 360 g
3) $97 \%$ of 8200 cm
4) I eat $52 \%$ of my box of cereal which started with 3700 g . How much cereal have I eaten?
5) A lorry has 18,300 iPads. It delivers $38 \%$ of its stock. How many iPads are left on the lorry

Look at Q5 again and see if you could calculate this in a different way. Show your workings clearly and explain which method you prefer.
